



THE LEADER IN ME

The *Leader in Me* project, which we started implementing in September 2019, is based on Stephen Covey's *7 Habits of Highly Effective People* and on his programme that allows students to change their paradigm, to make the right choices in life and that helps them to get ready for a society that is in perpetual change.



Currently, about 5.000 schools in over 55 countries are implementing the programme, which is aimed at pre-university education and equips students with essential personal and life leadership skills.

THE PROGRAMME

CHARACTER

Paradis International College has launched **CHARACTER**, the personal development program designed to support children in exploring and developing their potential in a safe and nurturing environment. This program aims to foster strong and authentic characters by emphasizing the following:

- the discovery and nurturing of talents,
- the overcoming of limits,
- the creation of team spirit and initiative.

Through active involvement in all sections, students will have the opportunity to build the foundation for success and character development.

The **CHARACTER** programme is structured into 4 sections as follows:

1. Discovering Talent

In this section, students will be encouraged to explore and develop their personal talents and skills. Through activities such as piano, guitar, drums, singing, art, robotics, programming, reading, etc., they will discover new passions and skills. This part of the programme aims to promote initiative and courage in self-expression, thus facilitating the development of a strong and authentic character.

2. Reaching Heights

In this section, students are challenged to push their physical and mental limits through experiences of adventure and exploration of their surroundings. Experiences in school and survival camps, as well as various outdoor activities, build self-confidence, resilience, team spirit and tenacity when facing challenges.

3. Pushing Boundaries

Physical activity is not only essential for physical health but also for character development. Through sports activities at school like swimming, football, basketball, mini-handball, martial arts, students are helped to develop perseverance, discipline and stamina. Through active involvement in these activities, they will develop team spirit and learn the importance of collaboration and mutual support.

4. Leaders of the Future with Initiative

In this section, the students will be encouraged to get involved in their community and become leaders of positive change. Through volunteering and community service projects, they will learn to apply their skills and values to contribute to the betterment of society. This experience will help them develop initiative, empathy and social responsibility, preparing them for leadership roles in the future.

Paradis International College has been a Cambridge preparation and assessment centre for more than 10 years and organizes language exams for all levels, from primary-level students, who take Young Learners Exams (Pre-A1 Starters, A1 Movers, A2 Flyers) to secondary-level students (A2 Key, B1 Preliminary – PET, B2 First – FCE) and high school students who take the IELTS exam. **These exams are internationally recognized and help students gain the success they need at prestigious universities and in various international projects.** Also, these certificates may be equivalent to the language proficiency tests for admission in high schools with bilingual or intensive programmes and for baccalaureate.

The high school curriculum framework offers two academic tracks: **the Science profile**, with a specialization in **Natural Sciences and bilingual instruction in English**, and the **Humanities profile**, with a specialization in **bilingual Philology**. The latter emphasizes the development of oral and written communication skills in Romanian as well as in two international languages. Both tracks are designed to ensure a balanced timetable that includes subjects from both the sciences and the humanities. This structure allows students to tailor their educational journey according to their individual interests and aptitudes, while also preparing them for a wide range of academic and professional pathways upon graduation.

* For Cambridge Advanced (AS and A2 together means A Level), students only choose the subjects that are necessary for their university entrance and that are to be thoroughly studied in the 7 to 8 classes per week of each of the 3 or 4 subjects that they choose.

Paradis International College – Cambridge curriculum allows students to choose the subjects they want to study, based on their skills and passions. IGCSE students can choose 3 out of 7 subjects in the 9th and 10th grades. The compulsory subjects for IGCSE are important for building a foundation of general knowledge: Mathematics, English as a first language, Science, and a second foreign language – German or Spanish. In the 11th and 12th grades, the freedom of choice increases to 100%, allowing students to build a personalized educational path tailored to their passions and goals. This system gives high school students the chance to study what they are truly passionate about, better preparing them for the university and the career they desire. In terms of elective subjects, Paradis offers a wide and varied range of 15 subjects.

STEM



At **Paradis International College**, we teach students to think creatively and innovatively, to look for opportunities where others see problems - in a way that is sure to make them prepared for the challenges of the future.

STEM is an educational concept that is based on the process of formation and education of the pupils and students in four main areas: Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, by using an applied multidisciplinary approach.

At **Paradis International College** we involve students in a large variety of STEM activities - from experiments, clubs, participations in conferences, competitions and scientific events, internships, to the VR Prisms project and "Nikola Tesla" Interactive Science Festival.

For the study of the STEM subjects, our students benefit from modern labs and from the facilities offered by "Nikola Tesla" Science Lab. In the new campus, there are **8 fully equipped labs** (two for each of the subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, IT) and one **Mechanics Lab**.



“Nikola Tesla” Festival

The annual "Nikola Tesla" Interactive Science Festival has been organized by Paradis International College since 2017. The festival has as its main objective the creation of a context where children explore their natural environment through experiential and interdisciplinary learning, where theory blends with practice, and which leads to the improvement of our students' skills of operationalization and transmission of scientific reasoning.

Over the years, during the festival, students have presented experiments and scientific works for all ages (from a toothpaste for elephants, water flames, magnetic magic, cosmic musical chords, sensory gardens, pulley systems, 3D printing to electric circuits, projects focused on green energy, hydrogen vehicles, the ECG smart device for the classification and prediction of possible cardiovascular diseases associated with arrhythmia and many others).

For each edition of the festival, we were delighted to welcome the visit of leaders in science that inspire the entire community: Alexandru Mironov - professor, writer and producer of radio-TV science shows, Cătălin Beldea - astronomer, Dr. Bogdan Iliescu - neurosurgeon, Cristian Presură - physicist, Vladimir Martinuș - mathematician, Silviu Gurău - physicist, Adrian Stoica - NASA expert, Mark Miodownik – professor at UCL, Emily Penn – environmental activist, Bettina Hohman - clinical psychologist, Rachael Livermore - astrophysicist.

The Universe has the same temperature everywhere

The temperature of the big bang is the same, but when we go to the far distant stars, "The world" is so that the temperature is 273.15°C. The lowest temperature possible is 0°C. As a result, the entire Universe is invisible.

99% of the Universe is invisible

Only about 1% of the mass-energy of the Universe is visible to us. The rest of it, which is 99% of the mass and galaxies and stars, is completely invisible. Arts

The goal of **Paradis International College** is to offer all the children who walk through our doors an arts education. This means understanding and appreciating arts and art projects and activities. Students take at least one arts activity at our school which will help them succeed in their preferred artistic field.



The skills students gain through art disciplines, activities, and clubs have positive long term effects, making a lasting contribution to one's complete education: students will have improved scores, will make stronger career decisions, and will become better rounded individuals.

Whether it is painting, drawing or ceramics, learning to play a musical instrument, performing in bands or choirs, theatrical performances or making designs with the help of 3D printers, there are so many opportunities for artistic expression in our school.



Visual Arts



The Visual Arts Club emphasizes a wide array of techniques and topics that allow students to find individual strengths and talents. This in turn leads to the steady growth of the club with students that have varying degrees of experience and diverse skills.



Paradis Music School

Almost half of our students of all ages take part in **Paradis Music School** activities, in a lively atmosphere that offers endless opportunities for self-assertion and performance. We inspire children to enjoy music as much inside classrooms as in show rooms or other unconventional places.

In the new campus, **Paradis Music School** benefits from **12 work spaces** for individual singing or musical instrument lessons and **4 rooms** for band or small-group lessons. There is also a **room fully equipped with musical instruments**, with an integrated concept of a classroom that incorporates a band space that will be used for group lessons. The Festivity Hall is equipped to the highest standards, and children can even enjoy playing a Petrof Grand piano.

At **Paradis Music School**, 10 teachers join forces, teaching individual lessons on piano, guitar (classical, electric and bass), drums, singing and coordinating the school's bands and the Paradis choir.



Dance

This activity is deeply loved and valued by the entire **Paradis** community and is a part of every celebration at the school. Throughout their school years, students experience diverse dance styles and traditions (contemporary, can-can, Egyptian, rock'n'roll, Bollywood, tribal, Spanish, country, Greek, traditional Romanian dances), under the guidance of their class teachers.



We take pride in the fact that **Paradis International College** students have taken the traditional "Călușarii" dance all around the world.

In the new campus, there is a special studio fully equipped for dancing activities.

The new **Paradis International College** campus benefits from a Festivity Hall with 200 seats, professional technical facilities (stage, stage lights, sound system, backstage, dressing room) and it is the place where children have the possibility to integrate and present the experiences accumulated in their drama, music and arts classes.



Volunteering and community service

As our students understand the importance of volunteering and community service in their day-to-day life, they become more empathetic, better communicators and stronger problem solvers. This way, they become aware that individual and collective efforts can transform communities and make the world a better place.

Volunteering and community service represent an integral part of the co-curricular activities at **Paradis International College**, students being encouraged to get involved in multiple activities: tutoring younger students, visits at centres for elderly persons, ecology activities (*Let's do it, Paradis! Paradis Forest*), supporting other education centres by providing equipment classrooms and supplying libraries (*Give stories – Dăruiește povești*), fund-raisings for different causes (*Day of Doing Good - Zi de bine, The Gift of Giving - Dar din Dar, Christmas Charity Fair*, and so on).



Tansa



- A Fantasy Place

Tansa – A Fantasy Place represents a very dear project for the **Paradis** community and an important way in which we honour traditional Romanian values.

This project had as its main objective the revitalization of the cultural and craft domain from Tansa area, a place that is representative for the authentic values of Moldavia. We could achieve this through: the design and arrangement of a village museum in the old post office building, the rehabilitation of a 100-year-old house using traditional materials in order to preserve the architecture and interior style specific to the area; as well as by bringing back to the socio-collective attention the most important craft of the village, the one that made the place famous – pottery.

During the four editions of **Tansa Volunteering School**, our students had the opportunity to bear witness to the stories of local people and about the museum pieces they collected - real lessons about the history of the Romanian village - and they understood that the language, the land and the traditions of our ancestors are part of each and every one of us.

Public Speaking

The activities dedicated to public speaking skills are a tradition at **Paradis International College** and they represent key points in our co-curricular programme. These events are meant for all age groups, from preschool to high school level, and they create the context in which students develop skills they will be using their whole lives: speaking confidently in front of a large audience, building arguments, speaking persuasively and sharing their opinions with others.

In kindergarten, for example, children take part in an activity where they present their passions to their classmates. Pupils from the second to fifth grade have the chance to practice their public speaking skills during the *Speaker's Corner* event, when they present their own opinions about a given topic (such as *freedom* or *leadership*).

From the sixth grade to high school, students participate in the Public Speaking competition, organised every year by English Speaking Union Romania, where participants give a speech on a given topic and they are scored on criteria such as intonation, non-verbal language and content.



DEBATE CLUB

The aim of this club is to support the development of the student's oratorical skills, persuasion, concision, active and critical listening, tolerance of opposing views and teamwork skills. Each debate session is an opportunity for learning, improving their general knowledge and practicing one's analytical thinking.

Even though our Debate Club is still very young, we have already taken part in *Sir Winston Churchill European Debate Competition*.



MODEL UNITED NATIONS CONFERENCES


The students from **Paradis International College** are excited to take part in Model United Nations Conferences both inside the country and abroad, which represents a practical exercise of their public speaking skills, research and use of English. From adopting the real resolutions of the United Nations to approaching current issues of the international community, the MUN conferences encourage high school students to think critically and rationally, to stay informed about major problems affecting the contemporary society and to express their ideas, in a coherent and persuasive way, in front of others. Our students have participated in many prestigious international conferences such as ENIMUN 2018, conference organized by Enka Schools Istanbul, November 2018, or CamMUN, Cambridge, December 2022.



Rediscover the City of Iași

Rediscover the City of Iași has been a beloved Paradis project since 2014. To promote our city and its surroundings in an innovative way, students from Paradis become mini guides for tourists (students and teachers from neighboring towns or guests from abroad), and introduce them to two tourist and historical paths: *The Way of the Grand Beginnings* and *The Way of the Hidden Treasures*. Traditionally organized by fifth graders, this event takes place every year and we are delighted that these tours can be offered in both Romanian and English.

This project offers our students the opportunity to develop their public speaking skills, the ability to analyse and synthesize information, the spirit of volunteering and active democracy, the students becoming aware of the importance of getting to know and to promote our city and developing their sense of belonging to a local community.



Paradis Media Academy



This is the club where middle and high school students have the opportunity to be creative and express their ideas and talent through media. In **Paradis Media Academy**, students make short film projects, learn communication techniques, diction, how to use photo-video equipment and editing software, make posters, interviews, reports. The members of this club produce **Radio Paradis**, they present, promote and report on school events.

At **Paradis Media Academy** we carry out activities to raise awareness of the negative impact that media can have on education and we turn this effect into a positive one. The development of media skills is done by using experiential and interactive work methods that stimulate critical thinking, metacognition, collaboration, tolerance and acceptance of variety.



Camps and Trips



From the first night far away from home in the upper kindergarten group to the multiple-week-long trips of our high-schoolers, our school's programme of camps, theme trips or survival schools widens our students' horizon, offers them a wide range of challenges and changes their view of themselves and of the world around them.

All these activities are organized by qualified and experienced staff members because **Paradis International College** puts the safety of children first.



Sport

At **Paradis International College** we focus on the health and well-being of each student. Therefore, we encourage students to get involved in sports activities, as they play a key role in long-term psycho-emotional and physical development.

Apart from physical education classes, about 60% of our students participate in handball, football, basketball, aikido and taekwondo clubs. The children are involved in inter-class sports competitions: at the primary level they have a football championship and, at middle and high school level, football and basketball ones.

The new **Paradis International College** campus benefits from a fully equipped sports hall, an indoor pool and two professional sport courts with night lighting system (one of them with artificial grass, quartz sand and rubber granules and another multisport field with tartan floor).

Furthermore, the new campus includes a well-being area, which will be used by students and teachers, with a fitness room and a sauna for halotherapy. These facilities will be managed by qualified staff in order to guarantee the safety of our students.



Even from primary years, our students have the opportunity to take part in international experiences that enrich and complete the curricular and co-curricular activities of our school. These focus on the experiential learning, in which our students get direct knowledge of the culture, language and traditions of the countries they visit.

In the 2022-2023 school year alone, 85 students from **Paradis** took part in many activities abroad: *the "Take Less and Be More" Round Square Conference at Oxford University, Great Britain, Cambridge Model United Nations (CamMUN), organized by Stephen Perse Foundation from Cambridge, Great Britain, the Erasmus+ group mobility of students at Herlufsholm Skole from Naestved, Denmark, the "Living the North" Round Square Conference, Ottawa, Canada, the student exchange experience at Mayville High School, Portsmouth, Great Britain, the theme trip to London and the student exchange activity at High School of Kogakuin University, Japan.*

Preparing for college applications

At **Paradis International College**, our students go through a long process of holistic self-knowledge and we support them at all times. Choosing the university and, later on, their career, is a priority; the students are guided throughout this process with their academic, psychological, and emotional needs in mind.

From the time of admission to high school, and then throughout schooling, we carry out detailed individual assessments, in which not only school psychologists and counsellors are involved, but also the teachers who guided the student until then.

When we advise students about choosing the universities to which they will apply, we take into account their skills and academic level, trying to find together the solution that will provide each future student with the optimal satisfaction of their intellectual and emotional needs.



The counselling and planification procedures intensify in the 11th and 12th grades, when our students receive personalized guidance in all the stages of the college application process:

- ✓ personality tests;
- ✓ research of career opportunities;
- ✓ internships and training courses;
- ✓ exploration of the study field and the analysis of the learning programmes of each academic specialization;
- ✓ gathering the necessary information regarding the atmosphere of the university they choose and the student life from those institutions – going beyond what can be found on official platforms;
- ✓ support during the process of writing the essays, cover letters or personal statements;
- ✓ getting letters of recommendation;
- ✓ organizing mock interviews;
- ✓ preparing and submitting the university applications and looking into the offers.



We work to create a network of partners in order to offer our students the possibility of having internships in the field of their interest so as to help them choose their university options.


Paradis International College Campus

High School Admission

Cambridge Curriculum

Assessing the candidate's academic knowledge in:

- **English Language:** **a)** the presentation of an internationally recognized language certificate (First Certificate in English at B2 or higher) or **b)** for the candidates that do not have a language certificate, there is an internal English Language exam, which consists of one oral and one written evaluation; in order to be admitted, the candidate needs to achieve an average score equivalent to the B2 level;
- **Mathematics:** **a)** the presentation of an official document testifying a minimum of 8.50 (eight fifty) at the National Evaluation for eighth graders or **b)** if the candidate did not take the national exam, there is an internal exam; in order to be admitted, the candidate needs to achieve a minimum of 8.50 (eight fifty);
- **Science:** when the candidate comes from another international school, he or she must submit a transcript to the secretary's office. If the candidate does not come from another international school, he/she will be tested from the area of science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics). The candidate will be considered admitted if he or she obtains a minimum of 8.50 (eight fifty).



The admission committee will offer an official answer in no more than 72 hours from the academic knowledge evaluation.



If the candidate is admitted, their parents will fill in the application form, will sign the tuition contract, will fill in the file and pay the admission fee (representing the tuition fee for the first month).



If the candidate is not admitted, the re-evaluation fee is 100 euros.





High School Admission

For the candidates who do not have a language proficiency certificate, there is an internal English Language exam, consisting of one oral and one written evaluation; to be declared admitted, the average of the two tests must certify the A2 language level.
- ❖ The presentation of an official document testifying a minimum of 8.50 (eight fifty) at the National Evaluation for eighth graders, for the case in which the candidate took this exam.
- ❖ If the interview and the evaluation of the candidate's cognitive potential take place before the National Evaluation final grades are made public, the candidate will be evaluated through an internal exam in Mathematics and Romanian Language. The candidate that is awarded a minimum of 8.50 (eight fifty) will be admitted. In the case in which, following these three evaluation steps, the candidate is admitted, he or she will receive an offer under the condition to pass the National Evaluation.
- ❖ The admission committee will offer an official answer in no more than 72 hours from the academic knowledge assessment.
- ❖ If the candidate is admitted, the parents will fill in the application form, will sign the tuition contract, will fill in the file and pay the admission fee (representing the tuition fee for the first month).
- ❖ If the candidate is not admitted, the re-evaluation fee is 100 euros.

Excellence scholarship

Paradis International College awards an excellence scholarship every school year to a student with very good academic results and co-curricular interests (with potential for development).

This scholarship covers the annual tuition fee for the entire high school cycle and is addressed to 8th grade students from any educational institution in the country. If the committee decides to grant two scholarships in a year, each will cover half of the tuition fee.

To apply, applicants will fill in an application form, submit both previous education documents and a letter of recommendation from a teacher, an essay detailing why they are considered suitable for this scholarship, and proof of parents' income levels.

If the scholarship awarding committee considers them eligible, the student will be invited to go through the stages of the admission process (depending on the curriculum they choose), with the following mention: when being assessed (the internal examinations or at the national exams) they obtain a minimum grade of 9 (nine) in Mathematics and Romanian Language and Literature.
